The Vision & Impact The Need

Children and youth facing the death of a loved one—especially when sudden or traumatic—are at greater risk of depression, anxiety, isolation, and suicidal thoughts.

In 2023, Campbell River Hospice Society responded by creating the Child & Youth Traumatic Grief Program—the first robust, community-funded program of its kind on Vancouver Island.

Our Response

- Individual and family counselling in schools and at the Hospice Care Centre
- Kids Together & Youth Together groups for connection and resilience
- Specialized grief day camps that combine healing and creativity
- · Creative therapies like art, mindfulness, and memory-making

All services are free of charge—made possible entirely by community care.

The Impact to date

- 934 children and youth supported
- 1,835 hours of counselling provided
- 67% of referrals come from schools

Families and schools report children showing improved coping, stronger emotional regulation, and fewer trauma symptoms. The ripple effects extend across the community—building resilience and reducing stigma around grief, suicide, and overdoses in our community.

Campbell River is the leader in community-funded and the first robust Child & Youth Grief Program on Vancouver Island—because our community cares.



Why This Matters

Without support, traumatic grief can derail a child's development. With care, children build resilience, find hope, and thrive, rather than falling through the cracks of society.

The Investment

The program has been funded at \$120,000 annually for the past two years. Due to overwhelming demand, the cost has risen to **\$142,000** annually, covering:

- Expansion of Kids Grief Camp
- · Hiring an additional part-time counsellor to meet the overwhelming need
- Added administrative and coordination support to sustain growth

Our Goal: 23 Leaders

We are seeking 23 business leaders in Campbell River to commit to becoming Founding Contributors:
